### **iQ CREDIT UNION BOARD MEMBERS NAMED TO VOLUNTEER HONOR ROLL**

VANCOUVER, Wash — The Washington Credit Union League has named iQ Credit Union board members Jim Sork and Scott Bieber to its newly-created 2010 Volunteer Honor Roll. Sork and Bieber were recognized with this award during the WCUL's Annual Business Meeting & Convention. The WCUL is the state trade association for the 117 financial cooperatives that serve more than 2.6 million Washingtonians.

"These men give everything they have to our community and to the credit union," says iQ Credit Union CEO Roger Michaelis. "They are excellent ambassadors to our members and responsible stewards of our financial health. We're honored they give so much of their time to the success of our organization."

Administered by the Washington Credit Union Foundation and the WCUL, the Volunteer Recognition Program honors and rewards volunteers within the credit union community who have exemplified outstanding leadership and service.

Sork, chairman of the board, has been a member of the iQ board for eight years, and is an active participant serving on various board committees. He actively mentors current and new volunteers, created a new volunteer orientation program for board members and encourages education and discussion. He is well-known among credit union members and staff and is considered extremely knowledgeable about industry issues and trends, as well as local financial products and services. A lifelong educator, he is the executive director of the Vancouver School District Foundation. He established Operation Fairy Godmother to secure prom dress contributions for low-income high school girls, and was instrumental in creating Family Resource Centers at many of the Title I Elementary Schools in the Vancouver School District.

Bieber, vice chairman of the board, has been a member of the iQ board for 12 years. Bieber monitors and tracks legislative activity as it relates to credit union issues, and educates the board accordingly. He oversees several board committees and actively engages board members of other credit unions in common programs. Employed by the Vancouver Police Department, he has also served on the board of the Clark County YMCA, involved with Rotary Club of Camas-Washougal, and is an active supporter of Clark College athletic programs and countless community causes.
