**IQ CREDIT UNION LENDS NEW BUILDING IN DOWNTOWN VANCOUVER
FOR POLICE TRAINING**

VANCOUVER, Wash. — The Vancouver Police Department will conduct SWAT training at the site of the former Citizens Service Center at 1313 Main Street and the Eberle Building at 110 East 13th Street in downtown Vancouver. These properties have been purchased by iQ Credit Union as the future site of its new headquarters. The police training has been coordinated with iQ Credit Union's knowledge and approval.

According to Chris LeBlanc, the training exercise will take place on Thursday, December 27, in the mid to late afternoon. "Passersby may notice what appears to be a police situation, but it will be a training exercise," said LeBlanc. "No iQ Credit Union staff or other workers will be present during this time. Police personnel only will be onsite."
